

**Open positions in District 15 are:** Alternate Chair, Registrar, DCM for Sub-District 4 (Dry Dock & Bayou Grp0 and DCM Sub-District 6 (Central Office & Tropical Attitudes)

Qualification for District officers:

- a) A minimum of five (5) years continuous sobriety for District Chair, Alternate Chair, and Treasurer
- b) A minimum of three (3) years continuous sobriety for Registrar, and Recording Secretary
- c) Any person serving as an officer must have served in at least one of the following positions: DCM, ACM, GSR, or Alternate GSR.
- d) In addition to the above qualifications, any person standing for the position of District Chairperson or Alternate Chair must have served in a District 15 Service position for a minimum of two (2) years that was within the prior four (4) year period.

The duties of the **Alternate Chairperson** include but are not limited to:

- a) All the duties of the Chairperson in his/her absence.
- b) Serve as Special Events Coordinator
- c) Ability to negotiate with personnel in charge of facilities when contracting for District 15 events.
- d) Good people skills and the ability to delegate tasks and responsibilities to those associated with the events.
- e) Individuals holding this office are subject to removal after three (3) consecutive unexcused absences from regular District business meetings.

The duties of the **Registrar** include but are not limited to:

- a) Maintain current records of all Groups in the District, including group name, meeting location, time, and G.S.R. or group contact.
- b) Maintain current records for names, addresses, and phone numbers of all elected officers, Committee Chairs, GSR's. and DCM's.
- c) Submit all current information of elected officers, Groups, and Committees to the Area 15 Registrar.
- d) Attend the District Registrar's meeting / workshops at each South Florida Area 15 General Service Quarterly.
- e) Individuals holding this office are subject to removal after three (3) consecutive unexcused absences from regular District business meetings.

The duties of the **DCM** include but are not limited to:

- a) Communicate with GSR's and groups within their Sub-District
- b) Attend their respective meeting / workshops at each South Florida Area 15 General Service Quarterly.
- c) As voting members, attend the South Florida Area 15 General Service Sunday Business Meeting to carry the voice of groups that do not have a GSR or can't afford to send their GSR.

**Note:** Sobriety requirements for a DCM and/or an ACM are a minimum of two (2) years continuous sobriety.
